Clay Township-Clayton JEDD Business Assistance Program

The Clay Township-Clayton JEDD is here to provide resources to grow your business. Funding is available to property owners on a reimbursable basis of up to \$10,000, but not more than 25% of the total project cost. A business/property owner must be in good standing with the JEDD and current on all taxes. Funds can be used for **Building Expansion or New Construction; Extending Utility Infrastructure; Interior or Exterior Site Improvements; Market Research Studies; or Job Retention.**

Sewer Assistance Project

SR 49 Improvement Project Update

The SR49 project will redesign the entrance and exits at the I-70/SR49 interchange to create a safer intersection. Environmental Clearance is scheduled to begin 12/2017. Designed to give small businesses financial assistance, the MicroEnterprise Grant offers \$2,500- \$25,000 for businesses who meet the following basic criteria:

- 5 or fewer employees
- Less than \$500,000 in annual revenue
- At least one year in business
- Has a storefront and is not a second business
